





Census: Race & Ethnicity












Vaccination Rates by Race/Ethnicity in BMC Area

COVID Community Impact Survey (CCIS)




In **November 2020**, the MA Department of Public Health implemented the survey to better understand the most pressing health needs facing the Commonwealth due to the pandemic, including the social and economic consequences.

- Over 33,000 adult respondents and over 3,000 youth (under 25) in the final sample.
- DPH targeted priority populations. There was good participation from LGBTQ,
 Indigenous, non-English speaking, Asian American, Latinx, deaf/hard of hearing, and black communities
- In the BMC Area, there were 2,376 respondents.

It is important to note that these findings are only representative of those who participated in the survey and may not be representative of the experiences of everyone in the BMC Area or have good representation from priority populations.




Worried about Basic Need Expenses (N=2376)

% worried about getting **broadband** in the coming weeks








% worried about paying mortgages, rent, or utilities related expense


% worried they may have to **move out** of where they live in the next few months

% of employed residents who experienced reduced work hours


% of employed residents who experienced **job loss**


